Notable Cases

On Monday, 07-28-14 at 5:55 a.m., Officer Gary Thompson was dispatched to 92nd Street and Sullivan Avenue on a report of a possible carjacking. The victim, a 33-year old resident of Broadmoor, did not speak English fluently, so his friend translated for him. The victim said he came out to move his vehicle for street sweeping and said as he was walking to his vehicle, an unknown subject grabbed him from behind, took the keys and threw him on the ground. He said before he could get up, the subject got into his car, started it and drove southbound on Sullivan Avenue. The victim said he just bought the vehicle, a 2004 Acura TL, two days earlier. The victim could only describe the suspect as 5'7", average build, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with black pants. This case has been referred to investigators.

On Tuesday, 07-29-14 at 7:20 p.m., Officer James Ho was dispatched to the 300 block of Peoria Street on a report of a vehicle that collided into a residence. Dispatchers advised that the subjects inside the vehicle got out and appeared to be leaving the scene. The driver, a 20-year old Daly City resident, was arrested for driving under the influence of marijuana and causing bodily injury to his passenger, a 19-year old San Francisco resident.

On Saturday, 08-02-14 at 3:23 p.m., Officer Nick Ottoboni was dispatched to the Thornton Beach vista parking lot on a report of a domestic disturbance inside a blue van. The male subject in the van, a 37-year old transient, told the officer he used methamphetamine during his road trip and believed he was being followed by people who intended to kill him. He denied any physical contact with his 24-year old female passenger from Wisconsin. The male subject had an outstanding no bail warrant from Sacramento and also a \$55K warrant from Wyoming. He was arrested for both warrants.

On Saturday, 08-02-14 at 7:20 p.m., a 41-year old San Francisco resident reported he was the victim of a robbery, carjacking and kidnapping near the Sun Valley Dairy Market on Schwerin

Street. The victim reported as he was getting out of his van, an unknown subject holding a large knife took his wallet, iPhone and glasses. The suspect got into the driver's seat and put the victim and put the victim in the passenger seat and drove around the block. The victim was unharmed. This case is currently being investigated by detectives.

Robberies

There was one robbery during the past week.

On Wednesday, 07-30-14, at 7:59 p.m., a JC Penney loss prevention officer was the victim of a strong armed robbery after attempting to apprehend a female subject for petty theft. The subject grabbed and scratched the loss prevention officer and took off with miscellaneous clothing and left in a gold Chevrolet Suburban.

Residential Burglaries

There was one residential burglary and one attempted residential burglary during the past week.

Between Tuesday, 07-29-14 at 6:00 a.m. and Wednesday, 07-30-14 at 9:40 p.m., an in-law unit of a residence on the 600 block of Southgate Avenue was burglarized. Entry was made via an unlocked bathroom window. The only item taken was a silver money clip.

On Wednesday, 07-30-14 at 10:30 p.m., a resident in an apartment on the unit block of East Moltke Street said she heard her dog barking and woke up. She said she heard and saw the bedroom window slide open, and she screamed. The victim said she turned on all her lights and noticed the window stopped moving. No entry was made, and the unknown suspect is still at large.

Commercial Burglaries

There was one commercial burglary during the past week.

Between Wednesday, 07-30-14 at 2:30 p.m. and Thursday, 07-31-14 at 6:45 a.m., Bayshore Elementary School was the victim of a commercial burglary. Unknown suspects smashed a window to gain entry and took soda, snacks, school sweaters, and an Apple iMac computer from various rooms in the school.

Vehicle Burglaries

- Trader Joe's parking lot—a laptop bag containing a laptop, an iPod Nano, two pairs of headphones, and a phone charger was taken from a 2008 BMW 328i. The right front window was smashed. Occurred on 07-28-14 between 7:30 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

- Home Depot parking lot—a backpack containing a bible was taken from a 2011 Dodge Caravan. The left rear window was smashed. Occurred on 08-02-14 between 2:30 p.m. and 3:45 p.m.
