



**NOTES:**

1. KEEP BERM FROM MULCH, FORMED AROUND THE ROOT BALL TO HOLD IRRIGATION, LESS THAN 4" HIGH.
2. WHEN PLANTING ON SLOPES, SET THE TREE SO THE TOP-MOST ROOT IN THE BALL ON THE UPHILL SIDE IS ABOUT EVEN WITH THE SOIL. BRING IN ENOUGH SOIL TO COVER THE SIDES OF THE ROOT BALL WITH SOIL. APPLY MULCH TO FINISH THE PLANTING JOB AS SHOWN.



**NOTES:**

1. REMOVE ALL SOIL AND MEDIA THAT IS ABOVE THE TOP-MOST ROOT IN THE ROOT BALL.
2. CUT OR SPREAD OUT ANY CIRCLING ROOTS GROWING UP INTO THIS MEDIA ON TOP.
3. POSITION THE TOP-MOST ROOT ABOUT EVEN WITH OR SLIGHTLY ABOVE THE TOP OF THE LANDSCAPE SOIL.
