Pacelli Gym every Tuesday and Thursday from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Pickleball ambassadors from the USA Pickleball Association will be there to instruct beginners in the finer points of a game that blends elements of tennis, ping-pong, and badminton into one fast-paced workout. Paddles and balls are provided to novice players. Spectators are welcome to cheer on their favorite pickleballers.

Nothing builds up an appetite quite like an afternoon of pickleball. Make your next stop one of the new restaurants that has opened in Daly City in recent months. Original Joe's of Westlake is still packing the house for lunch and dinner, while Steak and Shake is attracting curious epicureans to 362 East Market Street to taste test burgers that were pioneered at the chain's first restaurant in Normal, Illinois in 1934. Daly City's insatiable quest for the perfect burger spans from BurgerMeister in Westlake Shopping Center to In-N-Out near the Civic Center, and Habit Burger in the Gellert Marketplace. Dave and Buster's, set to open at the Serramonte Center, boasts "Legendary Burgers" along with a full menu that includes options for the burger-averse. A reporter from the San Francisco Examiner once used the words "food desert" to describe Daly City's dining options. Today, Daly City is a hamburger lover's oasis, with more options to come (yes, it is true, Daly City is getting a second In-N-Out Burger).



AARP FOUNDATION TAX PREPARATION

FREE TAX PREPARATION SERVICES

AARP Foundation Tax-Aide is a program that was started in 1968. In many areas, this free tax preparation is open to all ages with incomes under \$135,000. They welcome students and all Daly City residents who could use free tax preparation counseling for their annual filing.

Tax counselors are credentialed through an IRS tax education and retraining program, where preparers must qualify and be certified each year. In the past their tax clients come mostly from Daly City, particularly from the War Memorial Community Center (WMCC) and Lincoln Park areas.

In 2016, between WMCC and Lincoln, almost 700 returns were prepared, had refunds of about \$630,000, and brought in other tax benefit credits like EIC (Earned Income Credit), child tax and education credits and about a \$1,000,000 in combined Fed and State refund monies back for the Daly City community.

Tax preparation services will be available twice a week, beginning Wednesday, February 1 through Thursday, April 13. Appointments can be made beginning January by calling (650) 991-8018, for the following locations:





SEA TURTLES

(6 months - 5 Years)

Must be accompanied in water by parent or guardian. Students will be introduced to water environment, basic swim skills and water safety through games, songs and use of toys. Parental involvement in the learning process reinforces the parents' role in the child's development.

Toddler I: DUCKLINGS





REFUND POLICY

This Refund Policy has been established to provide refunds and credits resulting from the cancellation of or withdrawal from a Program, Class, Camp or League offered by or through the Department of Library and Recreation Services.

If, for any reason, a Program, Class, Camp or League is cancelled by the Department of Library and Recreation Services, the customer shall receive a full refund or credit.

If a customer wishes to cancel their enrollment and receive a full refund, the request for a refund must be made at least five business days prior to the start of the Program, Class, Camp or League.

Program, Class or Camp

If a customer withdraws from a Program, Class or Camp less than five business days prior to its start date, the customer shall receive a credit less a \$10 processing fee. AQUATICS CLASSES: If a customer withdraws from a class prior to its start date, the customer shall receive credit less a \$10 processing fee. Refunds shall not be issued.

If a customer withdraws after a Program, Class or Camp has commenced, the customer shall receive a partial credit. The amount of this partial credit shall be pro-rated based on the number of remaining sessions, less a \$10 processing fee. Refunds shall not be issued.

Youth Sports Leagues

If a customer withdraws from a Youth Sports League less than five business days prior to its start date, the customer shall receive a credit less a \$10 processing fee.

If a customer withdraws within the first three weeks of a League season, the customer shall receive a credit less a \$30 uniform fee and a \$10 processing fee. If a customer withdraws on or after week four, no credit or refund shall be issued.

Additional Information

A credit issued from a withdrawal of a class, program, league or camp shall be available for use up to one year after it was issued. If the credit is not used within this one year period, the credit shall be transferred from the customer's account into the Department's scholarship fund.

Exception to the Refund Policy due to extenuating circumstances may be considered by the Director of Library and Recreation Services.

No refund or credit is available for the following: Drop-in classes/programs, special events, adult sports leagues, camp extended care and one-day classes.


