The Plan is required under California Redevelopment Law and provides a blueprint for Redevelopment Agency activities over the next five years.

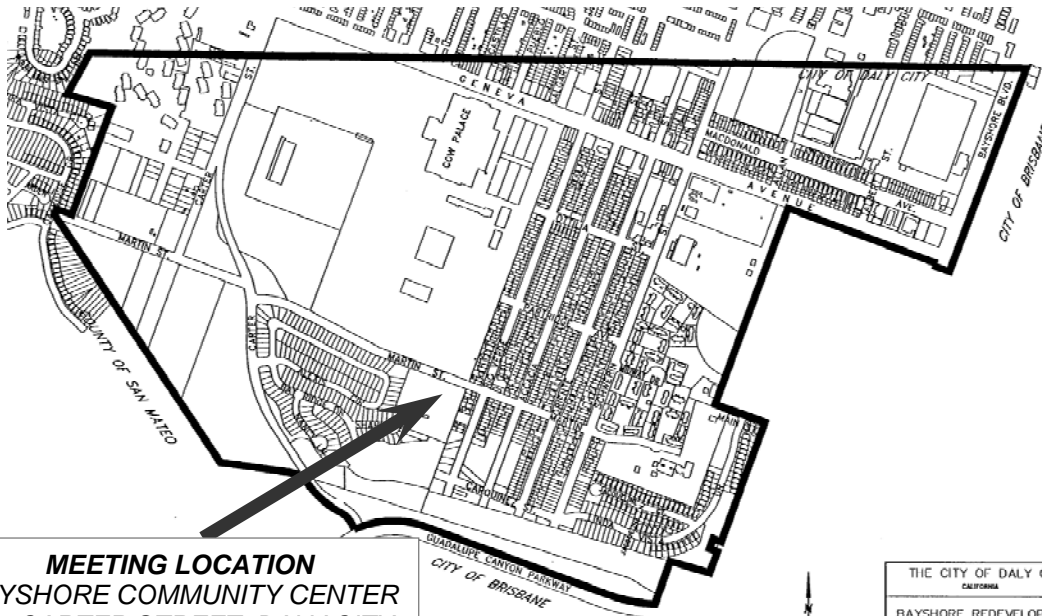
The major goals outlined in the draft plan are:

- Facilitate economic development by improving economic base, preserving and enhancing residential areas
- Facilitate the realization of neighborhood-serving uses such as a supermarket and pharmacy
- Improve infrastructure and public facilities such as adequate and appropriate street lighting signage, landscaping and sidewalk improvements, along with other public infrastructure improvements to support existing and future growth
- Promote and create affordable housing

The Plan provides an overview of prospective Redevelopment Agency activities for the Bayshore project area as well as an estimate of costs and projected revenues for implementing those activities.

The Community Meeting will include a short overview of the draft Implementation Plan and time for questions and answers. The meeting is designed to offer a friendly, open and encouraging forum for community discussion. The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, May 26, 2009**, at the **Bayshore Community Center gymnasium located at 450 Martin Street, Daly City** (see map below). The meeting will start promptly at 6:30 PM.
