

**REBUILDING TOGETHER PENINSULA
APPLICANT FACT SHEET**

BASIC ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Homeowners must:

- * Live in San Mateo County, Palo Alto, Mountain View, or Sunnyvale.
- * Meet Federal Housing and Urban Development Guidelines for low-income.
- * Own their home.
- * Live in the home they wish to have repaired.

Community Centers must:

- * Be located in San Mateo County, Palo Alto, Mountain View, or Sunnyvale.
- * Be a registered 501(c) (3) or a public school.
- * Serve the needs of low-income, elderly, and/or disabled clients.
- * Own their facility or have a long-term lease.

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

Rebuilding Together Peninsula is a non-profit, volunteer program designed to provide free repair and renovation services to elderly, disabled and low-income homeowners and community centers in San Mateo and part of Santa Clara counties.

- There is *no charge* for work completed by Rebuilding Together Peninsula volunteers.
- The project selection committee determines which homes will be selected based upon: our **mission**, the **number** of applications, the **need** of the homeowner or community center, our volunteers' **ability** to complete the required repairs and the client's **willingness to participate** in the program.
- The type of work completed by Rebuilding Together Peninsula includes: general clean-up, painting, plumbing, roofing, electrical, landscaping, fencing, cabinetry, flooring, appliances, carpentry, accessibility modifications and other repairs.

- The **amount** and **type** of work completed on each site is **different** and is determined by the volunteer project manager. Not all work needed will be done - only top priorities.
- Approximately 25% of Home applicants and 50% of Community Center applicants are accepted.
- Rebuilding Together Peninsula is primarily a *one-day* project.
- Work will be completed to the *best of our ability* by April 30, 2005.
- Rebuilding Together Peninsula has been doing this work since 1989. Our volunteers have completed work on 642 homes and 142 community centers.
