The Entrance Assessment Process:

- 1) Taking and passing *all* sections of the exam.
To review a practice test on line go to www.post.ca.gov, click on “Hiring – Exams/ Assessment,” scroll down the page and under Dispatcher, click on “POST Entry-level Dispatcher Selection Test Battery: Examinee Guide (applicant) for more detail.
- 2) Background Self Assessment
