 - Nancy: poet laureate is being chosen for Daly City
 - i. April 17, 2021
2. Heart Check – Mental health and wellness
3. Artist Felicita Norris - Feedback
 - Joanne: really enjoyed the art; left art open to interpretation
 - Liz: maybe offer her space in the Octagon Gallery; happy she is open to work with us in the future as well
 - Nancy: appreciated the format - the survey of her work; the way she walked us through the art; powerful messaging as a woman; an element of Frida Kahlo
 - Arlene: not many live viewers, but lots of views on Facebook Live video
4. Mural - On-going Project Planning
 - Propose location - War Memorial Center, 6655 Mission St. & others
 - i. Nancy: did a walk-around the proposed wall
 - 1. What do we want to create on this wall? Next steps? Should we include and honor the communities who were here and are here?
Focus on RESILIENCE during difficult moments
 - a. Liz respond: there are three sections
 - Muralists
 - i. Arlene Daus-Magbual has the Muralist Contact

1. Approached some artists and artists asked for a budget
2. The budget depends on art and vision
3. Engage the community: what would you like to see on this wall?
Maybe a survey?
 - a. Nancy asks Arlene: maybe have the kids involved?
Creates buy-in and investment in the community.

- Budget – Target Amount \$ 25,000., \$50,000., \$1000,000.
- Grants – Daly City, San Mateo County, and other Sources (need grant writer)
 - i. Liz has someone in mind for a grant but is busy at the moment
 - ii. Liz is looking for someone to write the grant for us
 - iii. Arlene: how do we receive/ask for funds for the projects that we do?
 1. Liz respond: approach David Canepa and supervisors
 2. Stephen respond: local sponsors is a great way to go; possibility to receive money from the City; target sponsors first
 3. Arlene respond: agree with Stephen; approach sponsors first
- Sponsorships – Corporations, Car Dealers, Benefactors, and Others (start word of mouth campaign)
 - i. Liz will build a spreadsheet with all the sponsors for our reference
 1. We will work as a team to approach the sponsors
 - ii. Stephen: look beyond Daly City
 1. Ask tech companies in the county
 2. Work with the artist with the budget and money we have
 3. Small Business Commission - maybe collaborate with the small businesses
 - a. Leilani adds: Youth Advisory Board - another way to collaborate
 - b. Arlene adds: give small businesses art to display in their space; sales from the art goes to the businesses and artists
- Proposal Letter – Liz Espinda (in the works)
 - i. Liz will revise the proposal letter and spreadsheet of all sponsors
- Facebook – Announcement posting for volunteer muralists

 - iii. Can we use this time to get educated about the issues happening?
 1. Nancy: communicate allyship; history of solidarity
 2. Arlene can teach it, but will reach out to other professors
 3. Arlene will also create the flyer


