Notice of Enforcement

State of California's: Short-Lived Climate Pollutants Law (SB 1383)

Informational Mailing – Not a Notice of Violation

December 17, 2024

Dear Business Owner, Landlord, and/or Manager:

Our records show that your site is *not* currently subscribed to organics collection services through Republic Services. This letter informs you that the City of Daly City will begin enforcing California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) as required by state regulations. While access to recycling and organics services has been mandated by laws AB 341 and AB 1826 and Daly City Municipal Code Chapter 8.80, SB 1383 aims to significantly reduce methane emissions by targeting a 75% reduction of organic waste in landfills by 2025 and rescuing 20% of food waste by the same year. Unlike previous laws, SB 1383 provides specific and detailed requirements for the City, businesses, and residents.

Key Requirements for Businesses:

1. Compliant Waste Disposal Options:

- **Option 1:** Subscribe to the City's recycling and organics collection service through Republic Services; this includes base-level recycling and organics service. Recycling is offered at no additional cost. Organics service is offered at a 25% discount over garbage rates. SB 1383 allows exemptions for *Minimal Generation* and *Physical Space Constraints*. - **Option 2:** Self-haul recyclables and organic waste to appropriate facilities. If this option is chosen, specific reporting requirements must be followed. Contact Republic Services for details.

2. Mandatory Actions:

- Provide sufficient recycling and organic containers for employees, tenants, and customers.
- Ensure bins are color-coded and clearly labeled with what can and cannot go inside them.
- Educate all employees, contractors, and tenants annually on how to properly sort recyclables and organic waste into the correct bins.
- Inspect waste bins for contamination and inform staff of proper sorting practices.

3. Additional Responsibilities:

- Specify in contracts with landscaping services that yard waste must not go to landfills.
- Inform new tenants about waste sorting requirements within 14 days of moving in.
- If applicable, establish a program to donate surplus food to food banks or other organizations.

Please contact Republic Services by January 10, 2025 to subscribe to organics collection service, qualify for an exemption, or verify your compliance with SB 1383. Effective the first quarter of 2025, your business/property will be automatically subscribed to organics collection service if your site remains out of compliance. The subscription level will be a minimum of a 64-gallon cart with service once a week for a monthly rate of \$57.28.

Businesses in violation of SB 1383 may be subject to penalties as defined by SB 1383 and Daly City Municipal Code Chapter 8.80.
