

RESOLUTION NO. 25-SD-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORTH SAN MATEO COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT APPROVING AND RECERTIFYING UPDATES TO THE SEWER SYSTEM MANAGEMENT PLAN

1. Staff recommends that the District Board approve and recertify the recommended updates to its Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP). The regulations are mandated by the California State Water Resources Control Board and require local legislative review and recertification every 6 years.

2. The SSMP has been the District's guiding document for operating and maintaining the sewer collection system since its inception. The regulations require each agency to obtain their governing board's approval of the updated SSMP and recertify the document.

3. The update includes three primary revisions:

- Compliance to the new and revised 2022 WDR
- Update Element 8 regarding the Sewer Master Plan and current CIP
- Address findings from the 2024 SSMP audit report


