Proper Disposal for Multi-Family Dwelling Units

REPUBLIC SERVICES

On-Call Bulky Goods Collection

Multi-Family residents are offered one free On-Call Bulky Goods Collection annually to get rid of unwanted items for reuse, recycling and disposal. Republic Services' Recycling Coordinators will work with property owners and managers to determine the best way to provide the service based on your property's needs.

Battery & Cell Phone Recycling

It is illegal in California to throw household batteries (AAA, AA, C, D, button cell, 9 Volt, and all others, both rechargeable and single use) and cells in the garbage, as they are considered Universal Waste. A permanent collection program may be set up at your property.

CFL Recycling

It is illegal in California to throw compact fluorescent lights (CFLs) in the garbage, as they are considered Universal Waste. A permanent collection program may be set up at your property.

Household Hazardous Waste

San Mateo County offers a free Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program to all residents in the County. It is illegal and unsafe to dump HHW in the trash or down the drain. First Violation: \$500.00

Second Violation: \$1,000.00

Third Violation: \$3,000.00

Property owners shall be provided a 72-hour notice of clean-up or will be subject to the additional cost of clean-up and disposal arranged by the City.
