Free Household Hazardous Waste Pick-Up for Seniors and Disabled

The San Mateo County Household Hazardous Waste program is pleased to offer a FREE service for the pick-up of household hazardous waste (HHW) directly from the homes of residents who are disabled, homebound, or over 65 and do not drive.

The Free HHW Home Pick-Up Program allows the County to service the HHW disposal needs of this growing population in an accessible and convenient manner.

Participant Eligibility

Eligible participants must be San Mateo County residents who are:

- Disabled
- Homebound
- Adults over 65 years of age who are unable to transport products

Pick-ups occur on available Wednesdays from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Residents must make an appointment in advance by calling 650-399-6919. The waiting period depends on availability.

Pick-up details are confirmed by phone, email, and/or postal mail prior to appointment.

Accepted Materials

- Aerosol spray cans (except food grade products like cooking oil sprays)
- Art and hobby supplies
- Automotive products and chemicals
- Batteries (home and car)
- Fluorescent lights (tubes and bulbs)
- Furniture and metal polishes
- Fuels
- Garden fertilizers and herbicides, pesticides, and rodenticides
- Household cleaning chemicals
- Old thermometers
- Paint, varnishes, thinners, and stains
- Pool and spa chemicals
- Photographic chemicals
- Propane tanks and outdoor cooking fuels (no larger than 20 pounds)
