The Westlake Park Senior Food Pantry serves Daly City residents, 50 years of age and older with free, preferred groceries from Second Harvest (Food Bank) of Silicon Valley including dairy and meat products, canned and dry goods, bread, and specialty items.

The Pantry is available for eligible seniors by appointment only. Pantry appointments are scheduled for twice a month by Daly City Active Adult/Senior Services staff. Appointments for the pantry are available on:

- 1st and 3rd Tuesdays between 1:00 PM – 3:45 PM
- 2nd and 4th Tuesdays between 9:00 AM – 11:45 AM
- 1st and 3rd Thursdays between 1:00 PM and 3:45 PM
- 2nd and 4th Thursdays between 1:00 PM and 3:45 PM
