## Redeem Your Beverage Containers

If you have any plastic bottles, glass bottles, or aluminum cans, you can drop them at Westlake Shopping Center at 99 Southgate Avenue, Daly City, CA 94015 from Tuesday through Saturday from 8 am-12 pm and 1 pm-4 pm. Check the top of your aluminum cans or sides of plastic and glass bottles for a CA CRV indicator. Please sort your containers in advance and ensure they are whole and free of contaminants. Daily load limits of empty CRV beverage containers are 1000 lbs for glass, 100 lbs for plastic, and 100 lbs for aluminum.

## Free Youth Bus Fair Program

Did you know that San Mateo County is partnering with SamTrans to provide free bus transportation for Socioeconomically Disadvantaged (SED) Students? SamTrans launched a six-month pilot program, Youth Unlimited, for SED students to receive free bus fare through the end of June. SED students that qualify include eligible students for the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Program, students experiencing homelessness, foster-youth, migrant students, and students whose parents did not graduate high school.

## Participate in Our Annual Earth Day Free Recycling Event!

Join us at our Annual Earth Day Free Recycling Event on Saturday, May 7, 2022, from 9:30 am-12:30 pm, located at the City Hall Parking Lot at 333 90th Street, Daly City, CA 94015. The list below outlines items that your household can bring to recycle:

- Secure Document Shredding: 3 banker size boxes per household.
- E-Waste Drop-Off: TVs, cell phones, monitors, printers, computers, cables, lamps, small appliances, and more. No large appliances (ex: refrigerator), lighting, batteries, or business waste are permitted.
- Mattress Recycling: Limit 4 per household. Items cannot be severely damaged or soiled. Toppers, bed frames, or pillows are not permitted.
- Used Tire Take Back: Limit 9 passenger or light truck tires, up to R19.5, with or without rims. No commercial tire, auto repair, or salvage business.




## Are You Composting?

### NOW IS YOUR TURN TO START COMPOSTING TODAY!

As of January 1, 2022, all Daly City residents and businesses must have organic waste collection per Senate Bill (SB) 1383. The state requires that Daly City monitor waste stream contamination by conducting inspections and enforcing compliance.

## Submit an Illegal Dumping Request via iHelp

Please report illegal dumpings such as mattresses, furniture, appliances, bags of garbage, and other bulky items in your neighborhood through the Daly City iHelp App. If you do not already have an account, create an account and select the "Illegal Dumping" field when submitting your request. Be sure to provide the address of the location, a picture, and/or a detailed description of items (i.e., three bags of garbage and one mattress).

Republic Services is contracted to collect and dispose of Bulky Goods illegally dumped on public streets and public right-of-ways within two (2) business days once Republic Services staff has acknowledged receipt.



To report litter and loose debris on public property, please be sure to select the "Litter and Debris on Public Property" field when submitting your request through iHelp. City staff will collect and dispose of these items within two (2) business days once staff has acknowledged receipt.

## Spring Cleaning Tip: On-Call Bulky Good Collection

Reminder! Daly City residents get one On-Call Bulky Goods Collection annually at no cost to get rid of unwanted items for reuse, recycling, or disposal. Placing unwanted items (even if labeled "Free") on sidewalks, underpasses, and even private property (i.e., in front of your home, at the corner of your neighborhood block, or in shopping centers) is considered illegal dumping and may result in an administrative citation ranging from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per Daly City Municipal Code Sections 8.32.100, 8.32.110, and 8.32.120.

Instead, consider:

## COVID-19 Mask Update

Daly City currently requires unvaccinated individuals ages 2 and older to wear masks inside government facilities. Also, all library patrons regardless of vaccination status are required to wear masks inside libraries to protect our community's most vulnerable members.

The State of California and County of San Mateo encourages all people regardless of vaccination status to wear masks in high transmission settings such as public transit, emergency shelters, health care settings, correctional facilities, homeless shelters, and long-term care facilities. While masks are no longer required in schools, they are still strongly encouraged.

If you or a loved one is not vaccinated or boosted yet, the San Mateo County Event Center is available for COVID-19 vaccines and boosters Wednesdays through Saturdays from 10 am - 5 pm. The entrance is at 1346 Saratoga Drive, San Mateo, 94403.
