



# NOTICE OF STREET WORK

## Mission Street Streetscape Project

City of Daly City, Department of Public Works, September 21, 2022

---

### ***DEAR RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS:***

The City of Daly City has contracted Sposeto Engineering, Inc. to perform streetscape improvements on Mission Street, between Crocker and Templeton Avenue. The project limits are shown on the reverse side of this notice. The work is scheduled to begin in October 2022 and is expected to be substantially completed by April 2023.

***Notices posted on street barricades will show the anticipated dates and hours of street work***

**Construction Activity:** The work includes installation of a new widened median, curb ramps, bulb outs, landscaping, irrigation system, The median noses will be extended further into the intersection at Wilson Street, Goethe Street, Evergreen Avenue, and Rice Street. Pedestrian improvements include bulb-outs, curb ramps, high visibility crosswalks, improved pedestrian signage, rectangular rapid flashing beacons, and pedestrian streetlights. Construction work hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday unless otherwise approved by the Engineer.

**Parking Impacts:** **No parking** will be enforced on Mission Street on days of certain construction activities. Dated “No Parking” signs will be posted at least 48 hours in advance of these days so you can relocate your vehicles. **Vehicles parked on the street during the posted hours will be towed when work starts.** Although you may not see the work start until later in the day, please do not park on the street when dated “No Parking” signs are posted.

**Rescheduled Work:** Work on Mission Street may be postponed due to inclement weather or equipment breakdown. The “No Parking” signs will be removed and you will be provided notice prior to the rescheduled work dates.

**Traffic Impacts:** Traffic will be affected on project streets at various times during construction. Mission Street shall maintain at least one lane of traffic in each direction at all times. SamTrans and MUNI bus stops may be temporarily relocated to the middle of the sidewalk. Traffic controls will be in place for through traffic. Emergency vehicles will not be delayed.

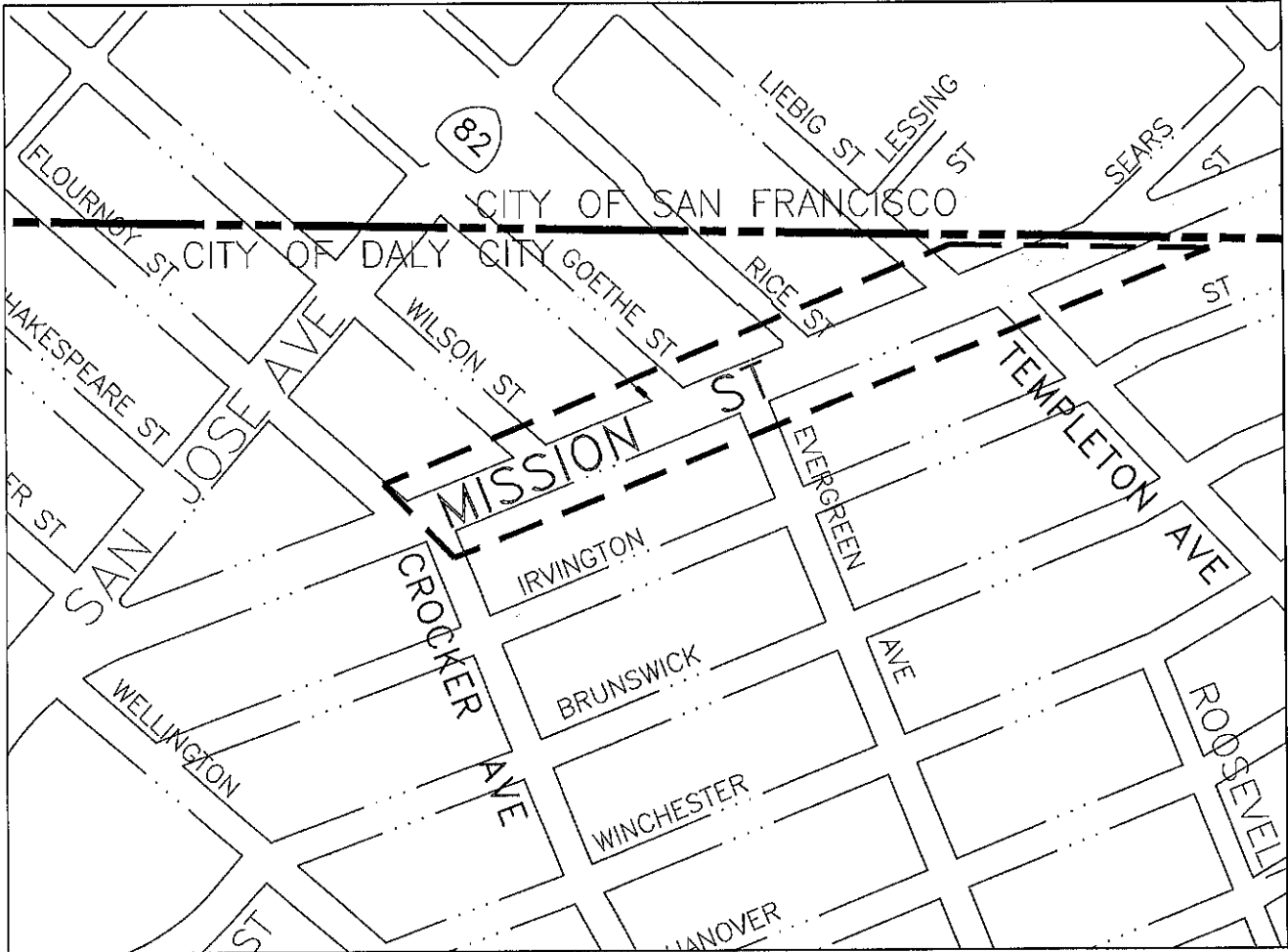
