Organics Recycling Reminder

California residents and businesses are required to recycle organics according to Senate Bill (SB) 1383. This includes food waste, green waste and food-soiled paper products. To comply, simply place accepted items like food scraps and green trimmings in the designated green compost cart. Republic Services will collect the materials and convert them into compost for community use!



Please note that certain items are not accepted in the **green cart**, such as plastics, aluminum, hazardous waste and pet waste. To ensure compliance with SB 1383, contamination levels in waste carts will be regularly monitored by Republic Services staff. Effective July 1, 2023, water rates have been adjusted by 4%. There are various assistance programs available. The Water Rate Assistance Program is a Daly City funded assistance program for water services. Eligibility is based on household income and qualifying applicants may receive a credit on their Water Bill that equals the increase in the rates approved by Council.

The Summer Learning Challenge helps your child beat the "summer slide," the loss in academic achievement gains made during the school year. Research shows that children can fall back one to two months in reading skills during the summer break. The slide is cumulative, so by fifth grade, summer learning loss can leave students years behind.

This Library program runs until August 31. Join anytime during the summer!

Tips for Managing Tall Grass and Weeds

As we enter the upcoming dry months, here are some simple tips to help you manage tall grass and weeds:

-  Make sure to mow your grass and trim or pull weeds when they grow taller than 12 inches.
-  Dispose of the grass clippings and fallen leaves properly to prevent them from being blown away on windy days.
-  Regularly clear away dirt and soil that gets displaced from gopher holes on the sidewalks bordering your lawn.
-  Plan and schedule regular yard maintenance for both the front and backyard areas.
